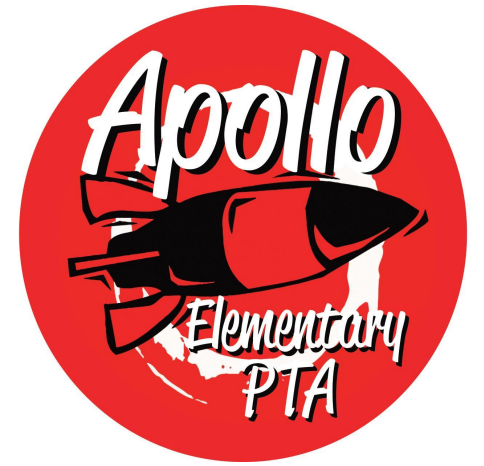

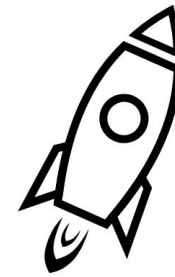

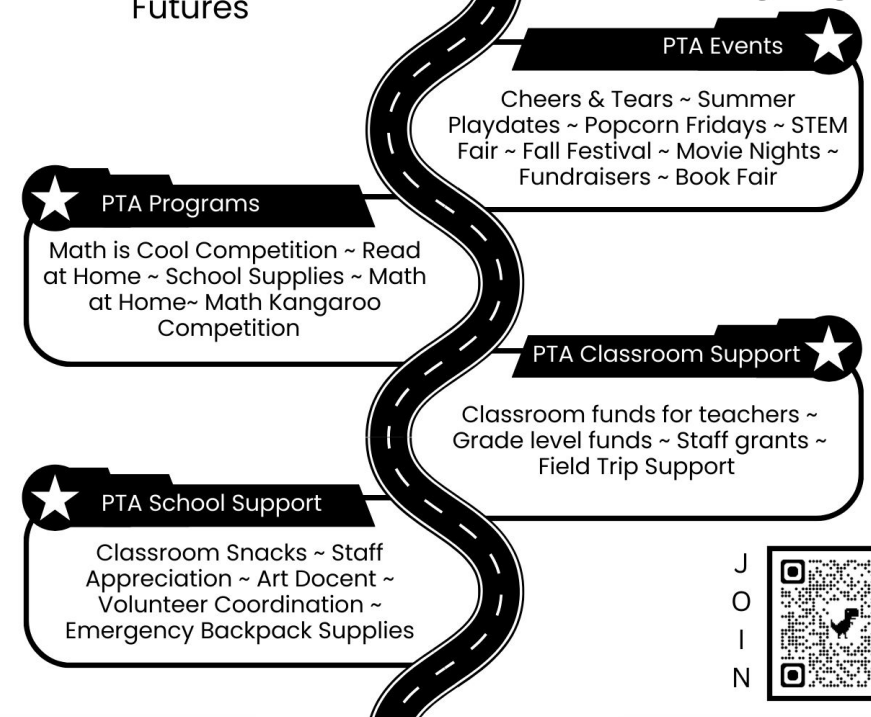

2025-2026 - Budget Review

- Review and vote
- Proposed Changes:
 - Move Book Fair from Category 2 (Fundraising) to 7 (Student Enrichment)
 - Move \$600 from Spring Fundraising Expense to Movie Night Expense
 - Move \$5,400 grant funds to grade level allotments. Grant applications no longer accepted for field trips.
 - Increase most grade level allotments from \$600 to \$1500. Grants would lower to \$4600. The increase is intended to help fund field trips in each grade.
 - TK: Increase to \$1100
 - K-4: Increase to \$1500
 - 5: remain at \$600 due to PTA funds for 5th grade camp
 - LRC I and II: remain at \$600 because students go on field trips with their general ed grade level teacher

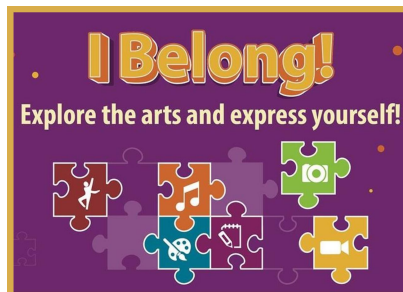


What is Reflections?

Advocacy - Shelby

- Issaquah PTSA Council Advocacy Committee
 - Discussion emphasized the need to expand our advocacy strategy to reach the broader voting base, not just parents
 - [Legislative Assembly](#) 2025 at the Hilton Doubletree at SeaTac, October 18 & 19, 2025
- ISD Budget Hearing Key Points
 - '24-'25 Projected ending fund balance = \$46M or 11% of expenditures
 - '25-'26 Projected enrollment = 18,500 a decline of ~1%
 - Enrollment flat at HS but declining in ES
 - Revenue \$400M, including increases from Special Education multiplier and MSOC increase. Key funding sources are ~70% state and 15% local EP&O levy (~\$66M)
 - Expenditures \$406M, including targeted curriculum implementations for MS and HS
